OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE MEETING
September 27, 2011, 5:30 p.m.

Members Present: Linda Trahern, Fred Collins, and Jim Sarvadi.
Also in attendance was Dan Dean.

Chairwoman Trahern called the meeting to order at 5:45 pm.

The Minutes of May 24, 2011 were approved.

The preliminary results of the survey complete by the Norris Design for the Master Plan indicated that high priorities for the community were trail amenities throughout the community.

The committee reviewed an area trails map prepared by JR Engineering. The committee would like the map extended to show the neighborhoods to the south to include the Liberty Ranch neighborhood, the new high school and the St. Vrain State Park. Secondly, they would like the map to show segment distances and connections. JR Engineering will be requested to update the map based on these requests.

The committee identified a number of policy recommendations for the Town. They are recommending that primary corridors be established linking the Downtown area to destination locations on the outer edges of the community and that all of the neighborhoods be connected to these primary corridors. Destination locations include Mead Ponds, St. Vrain State Park, Highland Lake, the St. Vrain River on the east, and Union Reservoir.

The committee discussed what the goals of the committee should be for next year. The consensus was to utilize the master plan being prepared to set goals.

The meeting was adjourned was at 6:35.
