An Oil & Gas Rig Movement Permit is required prior to moving a rig within the Town of Mead. It is acknowledged by the applicant that this permit, when issued, is valid only on those Town streets under the jurisdiction of the Town of Mead. To operate on roads within other jurisdictions, i.e., State Highways or county roads, it is necessary to obtain a separate permit from the authority having jurisdiction. By issuing this permit, Town of Mead will waive the Town's Oversized/Overweight Permits for the equipment shown below. The applicant is expected to meet the maximum weight limit of 20,000 lbs. on any one axle for overweight loads.

The purpose of this permit is to allow Town of Mead to maintain roads impacted by oil and gas rigs above and beyond normal wear and tear. The permit fee does not cover excessive damage including but not limited to: breaking of asphalt, damage to culverts or bridges. This permit applies only to the truck(s) directly tied to the moving of the rig. Support equipment is not covered by this permit, (i.e. water trucks, fracking rigs, etc.) and require a separate a Oversized/Overweight Permit for oversize/overweight loads.

Applicant certifies that he/they understand this permit is issued for the transport of the oil and gas rig only and a new permit must be obtained each time the rig is moved.

If the requested permit is granted, the undersigned agrees:

- 1. To take every precaution to protect the highways and the traffic from damage or injury, using pilot cars or flagmen to warn the traveling public on all blind curves, both vertical and horizontal.
2. In case of over width of load, the same is to be placed on the vehicle with the overhangs as far to the right as possible, and in any event the material shall be loaded as to present the minimum hazard to traffic.
3. To take this traffic movement only between DAYLIGHT and DARK, and to remove the traffic load from the highway except between those hours.
4. To be financially responsible and to make prompt payment for any damage caused to the traffic or to ,highway or to bridges by the transportation of this load in excess of limitations prescribed by statute.
5. That the operators of the vehicles are duly licensed according to statute.
6. To operate the vehicle or vehicles at all times in accordance with any and all provisions of law, except as exempted herein with regard to motor vehicles and the operation thereof.
7. A bond will be posted with The Town of Mead, if required, to cover the cost of damage to bridges and roads.
8. Applicant certifies that they understand and accept all provisions and requirements of this permit, including the provisions on the reverse side.

Note: Permit Not Valid on Holidays.

In issuing this permit, Town of Mead does not assume any liability in regard to the condition of roads or capacity of culverts or bridges. A designated representative from the Town of Mead Public Works Department and a designated representative from the Applicant shall meet on-site to inspect and evaluate the road(s) being impacted prior to the permit being issued. It is the applicant's responsibility to make necessary inspections of the road or bridge before proceeding with the rig move.

In case of an emergency, an authorized Town of Mead employee or an authorized agent may suspend the permit until emergency conditions have passed. Refer to Colorado State Statutes for any regulations not covered within this permit.

Oversize/overweight loads may be restricted from use of Town streets during periods when streets are wet and damage to the streets could occur. Bringing streets back to Town standards is the responsibility of the applicant.

The maximum weight limits allowed are as follows (Refer to Colorado Statutes 42-4-507 Wheel and Axle Loads and 42-4-508 Gross Weight of Vehicles and Loads.):

Weight: Two hundred thousand (200,000) pounds gross vehicle weight. Limit of 20,000 lbs. on any one axle. Subject to the maximum limits for axle weight designated on the Bridge Weight Limit Map.

Permittee must have a copy of the Signed Permit in vehicle(s) when operating or moving on Town streets and such permit shall be open to inspection by any Sheriff's officer or authorized agent of Town of Mead.

THIS PERMIT IS NOT AN AUTHORIZATION TO CROSS LOAD POSTED STRUCTURES.

APPLICANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEARANCE OF ALL STRUCTURES LOCATED IN TOWN OF MEAD INCLUDING OVERHEAD CLEARANCES.

PERMIT NOT VALID FOR TRANSPORTATION OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.
