

ORDINANCE NO., 8

NUISANCES

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for the owner, lessee, or occupant of any lot, lots or portions of a lot in the Town of Mead, to permit any weeds, wild oats, sweet clover, or other noxious growth, to grow upon any portion of said lot or lots, or upon the street, avenue, alley, or side-walks adjacent to said lot.

Section II. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a nuisance and upon conviction therefor shall be fined not less than three dollars no more than one hundred dollars.

Section III. It shall be the duty of the Town Marshal, whenever he discovers the existence of any such weeds, wild oats, sweet clover as above set forth to notify, in writing, the owner, lessee or occupant of such lot or lots to remove such noxious growth and if he fails to do so within seven days after notice, the Marshal shall cause the same to be removed at the expense of the offending person, the amount to be recovered if necessary by a proper civil action.
