ORDINANCE NO. 24.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ANIMALS AND THE KEEPING OR HARBORING THERE-
OF AND THE BOARDING, FEEDING, SELLING, EXHIBITING OR DISPLAYING
OF SAME AND THE SERVICING OR BREEDING THEREOF, AND THE FEEDING OF
SAME OR ANY THEREOF FOR MARKET, DECLARING SAID PRACTICES TO BE A
NUISANCE AND A DANGER TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD,
WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. No person shall keep within the Town of Mead
any pig, goat, sheep, buffalo, deer, ^{rabbit, chicken, etc.} elk or any species of the
bovine family or any species of the equestrian family, or any
other ~~large~~ domestic or wild animal, for board, exhibition or dis-
play, or for sale or auction thereof, or for the servicing or
breeding thereof, or shall keep any sty, corral, pen, cage or
other inclusion therefore; nor shall any person, firm or corpora-
tion keep or maintain within the Town of Mead any auction barn or
yard or keep or maintain any commercial yard, corral or pen for
the feeding or fattening of pigs, sheep or cattle or other animals
for market.

Section 2. Any such act or place referred to or
described in Section 1 hereof is annoying and offensive to the
inhabitants of said city, and detrimental to the health, welfare
and interests thereof.

Section 3. Any violation of this ordinance or any part
or provision thereof shall be unlawful and any person, firm or
corporation found guilty of any such violation shall be fined in
the sum of not less than \$10.00 nor more than the sum of \$300.00

Section 4. This ordinance shall not apply to nor prevent the keeping of house pets ~~for~~ animals held for personal use and consumption rather than commercial use and consumption provided all such animals other than dogs and cats shall be kept in a neat, clean, refuse free enclosure.

Section 5 This ordinance shall not apply to those persons presently engaged in acts and possessing places described in Section 1 so long as they shall not increase the number of animals presently owned, shall not increase their existing facilities and shall not transfer ownership of their animals or facilities to any other person, *clean & sanitary for use in other selling property (we get pigs for our own use)*

Section 6 If any provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, unlawful or beyond the powers of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, such determination shall not effect or impair *the enforcement of* ~~in force~~ ~~all~~ such provisions thereof as may be constitutional, lawful and within the powers of the Board of Trustees.

for each offense. Each day that such violation shall continue shall be a separate offense and shall be punished as a separate offense. In addition to the penalty herein provided for, the Board of Trustees shall have the right to apply for an injunction against any violations of the provisions hereof.

Section ³ 4. The Board of Trustees hereby finds this ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days from and after the final passage and publication as required by law.
