ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO WATER RATES AMENDING SECTION 1.A., SECTION 2., AND SECTION 3. OF ORDINANCE NO. 30 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF MEAD; AND WATER SPRINKLING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.A.

Ordinance No. 30 in which Section 1.A. of the Code of the Town of Mead is hereby amended to read as follows:

There shall be assessed and charged for the use of water measured through a meter, per month, from any of the water mains of the Town of Mead, rates and rentals as hereinafter set forth:

For water users inside the town limits of the Town of Mead there shall be charges:

For the first 7000 gallons For all over 7000 gallons

\$7.50 \$0.35 per 1000 gallons

For water users outside the town limits of the Town of Mead there shall be charges:

For the first 7000 gallons For all over 7000 gallons

\$12.00 \$00.35 per 1000 gallons

Section 2.

Ordinance No. 30 in which Section 2. of the Code of the Town of Mead was inacted is hereby amended to read as follows:

No charge for water shall be less than SEVEN AND 50/100 (\$7.50) DOLLARS per month for use within the town limits of the Town of Mead. Section 3.

Ordinance No. 30 in which Section 3. of the Code of the Town of Mead was inacted is hereby amended to read as follows:

No charge for water shall be less than TWELVE AND NO/100 (\$12.00) DOLLARS per month for use outside the town limits of the Town of Mead. Section 4.

From time to time, the Water Superintendent, pursuant to instructions from the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, shall issue proclamations regulating the use of water for sprinkling, and it shall be unlawful to use water for sprinkling contrary to the provisions of the said proclamations; and upon conviction thereof, violators shall be fined in a sum not exceeding ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$100.00) DOLLARS and costs.

Each and every ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 6.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead hereby find that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and this ordinance shall take effect FIVE (5) days after adoption and publication.
