ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO THE TAPPING OF WATER MAINS, INSTALLATION OF MATERIALS INCIDENT THERETO, AND CHARGES LEVIED FOR SAID TAPPING AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 29 AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF MEAD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COUNTY OF WELD, STATE OF COLORADO:

Section 1. Tapping Water Mains. Ordinance No. 29, Section 2, and all subsequent amendments thereto, of the Code of the Town of Mead are hereby amended to read as follows:

The tapping of mains and installation of all pipes, fittings, meters, and appurtenances necessary for conveying water from the main to the stopcock shall be done by the Water Department of the Town of Mead. The cost of each three-quarter inch tap, or its equivalent, shall be FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS for residential taps and EIGHT HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$800.00) DOLLARS for all other taps within the town limits, and shall be ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$1,500.00) DOLLARS per tap outside the town limits, plus cost of all pipes, fittings, meters, stopcocks, and appurtenances for conveying water from the main to the stopcock, all of which pipes, fittings, meters, stopcocks, and appurtenances shall become and remain the property of the Town of Mead.

Section 2. Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. All Ordinances, Resolutions, and Motions of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and repealed.

Section 3. Severability. The sections of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, provision, or part thereof shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such unconstitutional or invalid matter had not been included therein. It is further declared that if any provision or part of this section, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application thereof to other persons shall not be effected thereby.

In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect FIVE (5) days after passage and final publication.
