

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO WATER SERVICE APPLICATION FEES, WATER SERVICE DEPOSITS, AND WATER SERVICE SHUTOFF AND TURN ON FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. No water from the Town of Mead water supply shall be turned on for service into any premises by any person except that person authorized by the Board of Trustees.


Section 2. Application to have water turned on shall be made in writing to the Town Clerk, and shall contain an agreement by the applicant to abide by and accept all of the provisions of this ORDINANCE and other ORDINANCES pertaining to water service as conditions governing the use of the Town water supply by the applicant. A fee of FIVE AND NO/100 (\$5.00) DOLLARS shall be paid for turning on said water.

Section 3. A deposit of TWENTY AND NO/100 (\$20.00) DOLLARS shall be made with each such application, this sum to be retained by the Town to insure payment of all bills. When service to the applicant is discontinued permanently or at the end of NINETY (90) days, whichever comes first, this deposit, less any amount still due the City for water service, shall be refunded without interest. Provided, that where any applicant for water service is the owner of the premises to be served no such deposit shall be required.


Section 4. Water bills shall be due on or before the 10th day of the month following the reading of the meter, and if not paid by the 10th, water service may be terminated by the Town of Mead.

Section 5. Any case where water rent is delinquent and the supply has been turned off, the water shall not be turned on again until all delinquent water rents have been paid and until a service fee of FIVE AND NO/100 (\$5.00) DOLLARS shall have been paid to the Town Clerk.
