AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1976, TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1976, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1976.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead has adopted a budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1976, and ending December 31, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the proper mill levy upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town is 30.74 mills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purposes of defraying the expenses of the General Fund of Mead, Colorado, during the fiscal year beginning on January 1, 1976, and ending on December 31, 1976, there is hereby levied a tax of 20.74 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Mead for the year 1976.

Section 2. That for the purpose of defraying the expense of paying the interest upon and principal of outstanding bonds of the Town of Mead coming due in the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1976, and ending December 31, 1976, there is hereby levied a tax of 10.00 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of taxable property within the Town of Mead for the year 1976.

Section 3. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, the total tax levy for the Town of Mead, Colorado, as is herein set forth.
