## ordinance no. 93

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE 1st DAY OF JANUARY, 1982, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1982, ESTIMATING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY NECESSARY TO BE RAISED BY TAX LEVY BASED ON THE SAID BUDGET SO ADOPTED; ESTIMATING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY TO BE DERIVED FROM OTHER REVENUE SOURCES; AND SETTING FORTH THE ESTIMATED EXPENDITURES FOR EACH FUND.

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has been designated to prepare the annual budget for Mead, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1982, and ending December 31, 1982, and has prepared said budget and submitted it to the Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees held a public hearing on said budget on November 2, 1981, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has considered all relevant factors concerning the budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the estimated revenue for the various funds of the Town of Mead is:
