

ORDINANCE NO. 94

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1982, AND ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, 1982.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, has, by Ordinance, made the proper tax levy and mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town, such levy representing the amount of taxes for the Town's purposes necessary to provide for payment during the 1982 fiscal year of all property authorized demands upon the treasury, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado is now desirous of making appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year of 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO:

Section 1. The following appropriations are hereby made for the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1982, and ending on December 31, 1982:

General Fund:	\$ 45,779.00
Road and Bridge Fund:	\$ 33,363.00
Water Fund:	\$ 93,092.00
Bond and Coupon Fund:	\$ 72,576.00
Revenue Sharing Fund:	\$ 8,438.00
Water Construction Fund:	-0-
Park Fund:	\$ 5,527.00
Conservation Trust Fund:	<u>-0-</u>
Total:	\$258,775.00
