

ORDINANCE NO. 98

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR UNTIMELY PAYMENT OF WATER BILL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Water meters shall be read on the 1st day of each month, as nearly as possible, and bills shall be mailed by the 10th day of the month. All water bills shall be due on or before the 20th day of the month of the reading of the meters and if not paid on or before the 5th day of the following month, a penalty of TEN AND NO/100 (\$10.00) DOLLARS shall be assessed the water user.

Section 2. All penalties levied according to the provision of this Ordinance shall be due and payable immediately. Non-payment of any penalty levied hereunder shall be grounds for termination of water service as set forth by Ordinance of the Town of Mead and applicable rules promulgated by the Board of Trustees, Town of Mead.


Section 3. All Ordinances, Resolutions, and Motions of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead or such parts thereof which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and repealed.

Section 4. The sections of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, provision, or part thereof shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such unconstitutional or invalid matter had not been included therein. It is further declared that if any provision or part or section of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person, or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application thereof to other persons or circumstances shall not be effected thereby.

In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect after passage and final publication.
