## ORDINANCE NO. \_/0/

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE WATER RATES FOR USERS OF WATER FROM THE TOWN OF MEAD WATER SYSTEM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COUNTY OF WELD, STATE OF COLORADO:

Section 1. Water Rates. All previous Ordinances of the Town of Mead pertaining to water rates are amended to the extent set forth as follows:

- A. There shall be assessed and charged for the use of water measured through a meter, per month, from the Town of Mead Water System the following rates:
  - 1.) For water users within the corporate limits of the Town of Mead there shall be charged:

a.) Up to 10,000 gallons: \$13.00

b.) Over 10,000 gallons but less than 20,000 gallons:

\$ 1.00 per thousand or part thereof

c.) Over 20,000 gallons:

\$ 1.25 per thousand or part thereof

- 2.) For water users outside the corporate limits of the Town of Mead with the exception of Mead Elementary and Junior High Schools there shall be charged:
  - a.) Up to 10,000 gallons:

\$19.50

b.) Over 10,000 gallons but less than 20,000 gallons:

\$ 1.00 per thousand or part thereof

c.) Over 20,000 gallons:

\$ 1.25 per thousand or part thereof

- 3.) For Mead Junior High School and Mead Elementary School:
  - a.) \$1.00 per thousand gallons with a minimum monthly charge of \$470.00.
- B. The rates set forth in this Ordinance shall take effect on May 1, 1982.
- Section 2. Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. All Ordinances, Resolutions, and Motions of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and repealed.
- Section 3. Severability. The Sections of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any Section, provision, or part thereof shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such unconstitutional or invalid matter had not been included therein.

It is further declared that if any provision or part of this Section, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application thereof to other persons shall not be affected thereby.

In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect after passage and final publication.
