AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1983, TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1983, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1983.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, has adopted a budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1983, and ending December 31, 1983, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the proper mill levy upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town is 24.184 mills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purposes of defraying the expenses of the General Fund of Mead, Colorado, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1983, and ending on December 31, 1983, there is hereby levied a tax of 19.189 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Mead for the year 1983.

Section 2. That for the purpose of defraying the expense of paying the interest upon and principal of outstanding bonds of the Town of Mead coming due in the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1983, and ending December 31, 1983, there is hereby levied a tax of 4.995 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Mead for the year 1983.

Section 3. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, the total tax levy for the Town of Mead, Colorado, as is herein set forth.

In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect after passage and final publication.
