AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1984, AND ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, 1984.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, has, by ordinance made the proper tax levy and mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town, such levy representing the amount of taxes for the Town's purposes necessary to provide for payments during the 1984 fiscal year of all properly authorized demands upon the Treasury, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado is now desirous of making appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year of 1984.
