AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

- Section 1. Every owner or occupant of any premises within the Town of Mead having a sidewalk on or adjacent to the premises, shall have the duty to keep the sidewalk clean of snow and ice.
- Section 2. All snow and ice shall be removed within twenty-four (24) hours of accumulation.
- Section 3. For purposes of this Ordinance, premises shall mean any lot, parcel, outlot or other subdivision of real property whether occupied or not and whether or not a structure exists on the lot, parcel, outlot or other subdivision.
- Section 4. Any person, firm, partnership, corporation, or other legal entity owning or occupying a premises having a sidewalk on or adjacent thereto who refuses to clean the snow and ice from the sidewalk as provided herein shall be guilty of a petty offense and may be fined up to \$300.00 for each such offense.
- Section 5. All Ordinances, resolutions, and motions of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded and repealed.
- Section 6. The sections of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, provision, or part thereof shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such unconstitutional or invalid matter had not been included therein. It is further declared that if any provision or part of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application thereof to other persons shall not be effected thereby.

In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect after passage and final publication.
