

ORDINANCE NO. 158

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY, 1, 1988, AND ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, 1988, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, has by ordinance made the proper tax levy upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town, such levy representing the amount of taxes for the Town's purposes necessary to provide for payments during the 1988 fiscal year of all properly authorized demands upon the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, is now desirous of making appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year of 1988; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is required by state law to adopt an annual appropriations ordinance prior to December 31, 1987.

Section 1. The following appropriations are hereby made for the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1988, and ending on December 31, 1988:

General Fund	\$49,932
Road & Bridge Fund	17,650
Water Fund	128,405
Park Fund	5,550
Conservation Trust Fund	0
WML Circuit Rider Fund	40,552
TOTAL	<u>\$242,089</u>

Section 2. That the budget herein approved and adopted shall be signed by the Mayor and the Town Clerk and made a part of the public records of the Town of Mead.

In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect after passage and final publication.
