AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE Lat DAY OF JANUARY, 1990, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1990, ESTIMATING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY NECESSARY TO BE RAISED BY TAX LEVY BASED ON THE SAID BUDGET SO ADOPTED; ESTIMATING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY TO BE DERIVED FROM OTHER REVENUE SOURCES; SETTING FORTH THE ESTIMATED EXPENDITURES FOR EACH FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Circuit Rider City Manager has been designated to prepare the annual budget for Mead, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1990, and ending December 31, 1990; and has prepared said budget and submitted it to the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has considered all relevant factors concerning the budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is required by state law to adopt an annual budget prior to December 15, 1989.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO:
