

ORDINANCE NO. 194

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY, 1, 1991, AND ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, 1991, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, has by ordinance made the proper tax levy upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town, such levy representing the amount of taxes for the Town's purposes necessary to provide for payments during the 1991 fiscal year of all properly authorized demands upon the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, is now desirous of making appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year of 1991; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is required by state law to adopt an annual appropriations ordinance prior to December 15, 1990.

Section 1. The following appropriations are hereby made for the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1991, and ending on December 31, 1991:

Water Fund	124,861
WIM Circuit Rider Fund	57,300
Park Fund	6,000
Park Development Reserve Fund	3,000
Conservation Trust Fund	3,000

Section 2. In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect after passage.

PASSED AND ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTERS OF THE TOWN OF MEAD THIS 12th DAY OF December, 1990, AND ORDERED TO BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ADOPTION.
