

ORDINANCE NO. 196

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO DURING THE FISCAL YEAR OF 1990, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees authorized the expenditure of certain funds from the Road and Bridge Fund for the repair and maintenance of certain streets and roadways; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the total cost of these expenses will cause the total Road and Bridge Fund expenditures to exceed the amounts budgeted; and

WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1990 budget; and

WHEREAS, additional funds have been received by the Road and Bridge Fund in the form of the additional sales and use tax collections which could not be anticipated at the time of the 1990 budget adoption to cover these additional expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado;

Section 1. That the 1990 appropriation for the Road and Bridge Fund is hereby increased from \$41,399 to \$61,960.

Section 2. That the sum of \$20,561 is hereby transferred from the proceeds of additional sales and use tax collections to the Road and Bridge Fund.

Section 3. That the 1990 budget is hereby amended to reflect the increased expenditures from the Road and Bridge Fund as provided in Section 1, of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Validity. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, provision or part thereof shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being the intent of the Board of Trustees that this ordinance would have been adopted even if such unconstitutional or invalid matter had not been included herein. It is further declared that if any section, provision or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, if held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application thereof to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Necessity. In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation and protection of the health, safety, welfare and property of the inhabitants and owners of property in the Town of Mead.
