TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO ORDINANCE 200

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE MEAD MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE CLASSIFICATION OF OFFENSES AS PETTY OFFENSES OR MISDEMEANORS

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD HAS DETERMINED THAT IT IS NECESSARY TO AMEND SEVERAL CODE PROVISIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter 7, Section 4, Subsections 1 through 12, of the Mead Town Code, 1986, are hereby amended to read:

Violation of this provision is a petty offense.

<u>Section 2</u>. Chapter 16, Section 8, Subsection 3, of the Mead Town Code, 1986, entitled "Cruelty to Animals," is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. Chapter 13, Section 1, Subsection 5, of the Mead Town Code, 1986, entitled "Littering Prohibited," is hereby repealed.
