

**TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 742**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, REPEALING
SECTION 11-3-10 AND SECTION 11-3-20 OF THE MEAD MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, there are certain fees established by ordinance for the reservation of Town owned park facilities and the use of Town-owned recreation equipment; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the fees established for these purposes have not kept up with the actual cost or value of the services provided; and

WHEREAS, it is a desire of the Board of Trustees to allow the establishment of fees for the reservation of Town owned park facilities and the use of Town owned recreation equipment and to allow the promulgation of Park Rules administratively:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, that:

Section 1. Section 11-3-10 of the *Mead Municipal Code* as it relates to the reservation park facilities is hereby repealed in its entirety and reenacted to read as follows:

“Sec. 11-3-10. Reservation of park facilities.

Fees for the reservation of Town park facilities are to be established administratively by the Town Manager and may be adjusted from time to time as deemed appropriate.”

Section 2. Section 11-3-20 of the *Mead Municipal Code* as it relates to the use of Town-owned recreation equipment is hereby repealed in its entirety and reenacted to read as follows:

“Sec. 11-3-20. Recreation equipment deposit.

Deposits for the use of Town-owned recreation equipment are to be established administratively by the Town Manager and may be adjusted from time to time as deemed appropriate.”

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.

Section 4. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentence, clauses or phrases are declared invalid.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

Section 6. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and

make not less than one copy of the adopted Code available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
