RESOLUTION NO. 22-R-2005**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, REGARDING THE
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF FAIRBAIRN AVENUE
BETWEEN 2nd STREET AND 3rd STREET IN THE TOWN OF MEAD.**

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Trustees to be in the best interest of the Town to allow the temporary closure of Fairbairn Avenue between 2nd Street and 3rd Street, said closure to restrict pedestrian and vehicular use of the unimproved portion of Fairbairn Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said closure is to protect the health safety and welfare of the area residents; and

WHEREAS, the closure of Fairbairn Avenue will not affect the public utility easements and their appurtenances contained therein;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO; THAT;

Section 1. That portion of Fairbairn Avenue between 2nd Street and 3rd Street is hereby temporarily closed to through pedestrian and vehicular traffic, said closure to be accomplished by fencing or other means approved by the Town and provided by American Pride Co-Op.

Section 2. That portion of Fairbairn Avenue between 2nd Street and 3rd Street may be reopened at any future time at the sole discretion of the Town and the fencing or other means of closure shall be removed by American Pride Co-Op upon request by the Town.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.

Section 5. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
