TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO. 9-R-2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 6-R-2004 TO EXEMPT FROM THE TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON ACCEPTANCE FOR PROCESSING OF ANY NEW PETITIONS FOR ANNEXATION TO THE TOWN, THE APPLICATION FOR THE SCHMIDT-HILGERS ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead established a temporary moratorium on acceptance for processing of any new petitions for annexation to the Town by Resolution No. 6-R-2004; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead provided for the exemption of seven developments from the temporary moratorium; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is appropriate to exempt from the temporary moratorium, the consideration of a petition for the Schmidt-Hilgers Annexation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO; THAT;

- Section 1. Section 2, Resolution No. 6-R-2004 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "Section 2. At this time there are eight developments that have submitted annexation petitions or development proposals, that are being processed by staff in preparation for presentation to the Board of Trustees and they are therefore exempted from the moratorium. These annexations and development proposals are: the Meadow Ridge Annexation, Frederiksen Farms Annexation, the unannexed portions of the Sekich Business Park, the Grandview Estates III Annexation, Margil Farms Preliminary Plat, Vale View Replat A, Highland Lake Estates Annexation and the Schmidt-Hilgers Annexation."
- Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be become effective immediately upon adoption.
- **Section 3.** Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.
- **Section 4.** Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
