TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO. 30-R-2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, ADOPTING THE NORTHEAST COLORADO EMERGENCY MANAGERS (NCEM) MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead, a Colorado municipal corporation, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has been presented with the Northeast Colorado Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for the County of Weld, State of Colorado, by and through the Board of County Commissioners of Weld County, on behalf of the Office of Emergency Management, with terms and conditions being as stated in said plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre-and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead resides in Weld County, Colorado, which is within the 11-county NCEM Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Office of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials have reviewed the NCEM Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption by the participating governments and entities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, that:

- **Section 1.** The NCEM Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official plan for the undertaking of hazard mitigation planning, and appropriate preventive and remedial actions by the Town of Mead.
- Section 2. NCEM will, on the Town's behalf, submit this resolution to the Colorado Office of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials, to enable final approval of the NCEM Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan.
- **Section 3.** The Mayor and Town Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to certify this resolution and take those steps necessary to effectuate its implementation.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

- Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.
- Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and Section 6. make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
