

**TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO
RESOLUTION NO. 4-R-2003**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD COLORADO, DECLARING THE
BOARD OF TRUSTEES STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH HB 01S2-1006,
CONCERNING THE STATUTORY ADOPTION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT
MASTER PLANS.**

WHEREAS, in the Second Extraordinary Session of 2001, the Colorado General Assembly passed HB 1-S2-1006, requiring certain municipalities and counties to adopt master plans, also known as comprehensive plans, for the development of their communities; and

WHEREAS, HB 1-S2-1006 also requires that such plan contain a "recreation and tourism element," pursuant to which the municipality "shall indicate how it intends to provide for the recreational and tourism needs of residents of the municipality and visitors to the municipality through delineated areas dedicated to, without limitation, hiking, mountain biking, rock climbing, skiing, cross-country skiing, rafting, fishing, boating, hunting, and shooting, or any other form of sport or other recreational activity, as applicable, and commercial facilities supporting such uses;" and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead adopted a comprehensive plan entitled the *Mead Area Comprehensive Plan* on March 19, 1997; and

WHEREAS, the Town's plan addresses the recreation and tourism requirement of HB 1-S2-1006 in the following manner:

Section VII, Parks and Open Space of the plan provides for the creation of parks, bicycle/pedestrian trails, recreational activities and facilities, open space, and similar public benefits.


WHEREAS, this information provided in the Town's existing plan describes how the Town intends to provide for the recreational and tourism needs of both residents of the Town and visitors to the Town.

TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO; THAT:**


The Town hereby finds and declares that it is in compliance with the requirements of HB 1-S2-1006 requiring a recreation and tourism element in its master or comprehensive plan.
