RESOLUTION NUMBER 26-R-2003

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2004, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO FOR THE 2004 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 8, 2003, and:

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$385,838, and;

WHEREAS, the 2003 valuation for assessment for the Town of Mead as certified by the County Assessor is \$29,959,930.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Mead during the 2004 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 12.879 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town of Mead for the year 2004.

Section 2. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Mead as herein set forth.
