A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO AUTHORIZING THE ACTING CLERK TO APPOINT ELECTION JUDGES FOR THE SANBORN ANNEXATION ELECTION TO BE HELD ON OCTOBER 1, 2002 AND ESTABLISHING A RATE OF PAY

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead will hold a special election to consider the Sanborn annexation on October 1, 2002, and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 31-10-401, requires the governing body of the municipality by resolution to delegate the authority and responsibility to appoint judges of the election at least 15 days prior to election day to the Town Clerk; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 31-10-408, establishes that election judges will be paid not less than five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars for their services during the election, the amount to be determined by the governing body of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead is the governing body for the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, that Michael D. Friesen, Acting Town Clerk, is hereby authorized to appoint the election judges for the October 1, 2002 Sanborn annexation election, in accordance with Colorado Revised Statutes. The appointed judges will receive \$75.00 for their services.
