RESOLUTION NO. 21-R-2002

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD BOARD OF TRUSTEES EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR BALLOT ISSUE 3A WHICH AUTHORIZES BONDED DEBT FOR THE ST. VRAIN VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT RE-1J

WHEREAS, many of the school-age children residing within the Town of Mead attend St. Vrain Valley School District RE1J; and

WHEREAS, at the November 5, 2002, election, the St. Vrain Valley School District will ask voters to approve a bond issue for \$219.9 million for ten new schools, building systems replacements, remodels and additions, safety and security, technology and athletics; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead finds that adoption of this ballot issue is therefore in the best interests of the Town of Mead and its citizens and should be supported; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Campaign Practices Act, C.R.S. 1-45-117(1)(b) authorizes the Town's adoption of a resolution and the taking of a position of advocacy on any pending issue before the electorate;

NOW, THEREFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLVES:

- 1. <u>Section 1.</u> That the Board supports the 2002 St. Vrain School District's bond issue in the amount of \$219.9 million.
 - 2. <u>Section 2.</u> This resolution will take effect immediately upon adoption.
