A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD COLORADO, ESTABLISHING PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 31-10-502 provides that the governing body of each municipality shall divide the municipality into as many election precincts for municipal elections as it deems expedient for the convenience of electors of said municipality; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of each municipality shall designate the location and address of a polling place for each precinct, at which elections are to be held;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO; THAT;

- **Section 1.** All territory within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Mead, as of this date and as may be annexed from time to time, is hereby designated as Precinct 1, with the polling place for said Precinct 1 to be the Mead Town Hall, 441 3rd Street, Mead, Colorado 80542.
- Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be become effective immediately upon adoption.
- **Section 3.** Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.
- **Section 4. Certification.** The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
