A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK TO APPOINT ELECTION JUDGES AND ESTABLISHING A RATE OF PAY


WHEREAS, the Town of Mead holds general and special municipal elections from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 31-10-401, requires the governing body of the municipality to appoint election judges at least 15 days before each municipal election by resolution, or to delegate the authority and responsibility to appoint election judges to the Town Clerk; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 31-10-408, establishes that election judges will be paid not less than five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars for their services during the election, the amount to be determined by the governing body of the municipality;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to appoint the election judges for regular and special municipal elections, in accordance with Colorado Revised Statutes. The appointed judges will receive \$75.00 for their services. The judges will also receive \$5.00 for attending an instructional meeting. The supply judge will be paid an additional \$4.00.

PASSED AND ADOPTED ON THIS 30 TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2002, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, AND ORDERED TO BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AFTER PASSAGE.
