A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE VARIOUS FUNDS AND SPENDING AGENCIES, IN THE AMOUNT AND FOR THE PURPOSE AS SET FORTH BELOW, FOR THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE 2003 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 9, 2002, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead has made provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget, and;

Section 1. That the following sums are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for purposes stated:
