

RESOLUTION NO. 4-R-2001

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK TO APPOINT ELECTION JUDGES FOR MEAD'S 2001 SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 10, 2001 AND ESTABLISHING A RATE OF PAY**


WHEREAS, Section 31-10-401 of the Colorado Revised Statutes allows the governing body of the municipality by resolution to delegate the authority and responsibility to appoint judges for the municipal election to the Town Clerk, and

WHEREAS, Section 31-10-408 of the Colorado Revised Statutes allows the governing body of the municipality to determine the compensation of election judges for their services, and

WHEREAS, Section 1-6-115 of the Colorado Revised Statutes states that compensation for judges be not less than five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, that Judy Hegwood, Town Clerk, is hereby authorized to appoint election judges for the April 10, 2001 Mead Municipal Election, in accordance with the Colorado Revised Statutes. The appointed judges will receive \$75.00 for their services.
