## TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO. 15-R-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD COLORADO, ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE SALE OF ANY NEW WATER TAPS WITHIN THE TOWN.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead has not amended its uniform capital investment, water acquisition and connection fees since 1997; and

WHEREAS, during this period, the cost of acquiring water rights has risen significantly; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees needs sufficient time to complete the preparation, study and evaluation of the uniform capital investment, water acquisition and connection fees that will affect development policies within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that a delay in selling further water taps on the Town's system, said delay being temporary, for a period of 45 days from the date of adoption of this resolution, unless sooner repealed, is necessary to the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the town of Mead: and

WHEREAS, it is the expressed intent of the Board of Trustees that this Resolution is adopted nunc pro tunc on June 25, 2001;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO THAT;

Section 1. There is hereby established a temporary moratorium on the sale of water taps within the Town of Mead effective for a period of 45 calendar days from June 25, 2001, unless sooner repealed by the Board of Trustees.

Section 2. This Resolution is adopted nunc pro tune on June 25, 2001.

Section 3. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
