## TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO.20-R-2001

## A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, AMENDING THE COORDINATED PLANNING AGREEMENT URBAN GROWTH AREA MAP.

WHEREAS, certain lands eligible for amexation to the Town of Mead, but outside the boundaries of the Urban Growth Area Map established by the Coordinated Planning Agreement between Weld County and the Town have expressed interest in an annexation to the Town; and

WHEREAS, it is a desire of the Board of Trustees to consider the expansion of the current boundaries of the Urban Growth Area Map by amendment to incorporate those areas of mutual interest into the Urban Growth Area Map.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO; THAT;

- Section 1. The Urban Growth Area Map is hereby amended to include those areas within the boundary depicted in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part here of and shall be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners as an amendment to be Urban Growth Area Map adopted by the Coordinated Planning Agreement.
- Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be become effective immediately upon adoption.
- Section 3. Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.
- Section 4. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
