

RESOLUTION NO. 27-R-2001

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK TO APPOINT ELECTION JUDGES FOR MEAD'S 2001 SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON DECEMBER 11, 2001 AND ESTABLISHING A RATE OF PAY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead's 2001 Special Election will be held on December 11, 2001; and


WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statute, 31-10-401, requires the governing body of the municipality by resolution to delegate the authority and responsibility to the Town Clerk, to appoint judges of the election at least 15 days prior to election day; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statute, 31-10-408, establishes that election judges will be paid not less than five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars for their services during the election, the amount to be determined by the governing body of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead is the governing body for the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, that Judy Hegwood, Town Clerk is hereby authorized to appoint the election judges for the December 11, 2001 Mead Special Election, in accordance with the Colorado Revised Statutes. The appointed judges will receive \$75.00 for their services.
