**A Resolution Supporting the St. Vrain Valley School District Bond Issue  
at the November 6, 2001 Election**

**WHEREAS**, many of the school age children residing within the Town of Mead attend St. Vrain Valley School District RE-1J; and

**WHEREAS**, at the November 6, 2001 election, the St. Vrain Valley School District will be asking voters to approve a bond issue; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mead Board of Trustees finds that approval of this bond issue is necessary for the School District to provide adequate educational opportunities to children in Mead who attend these schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mead Board of Trustees finds adoption of this ballot issue is therefore in the best interests of the Town and its citizens and should be supported; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fair Campaign Practices Act, C.R.S. 1-45-117(1)(b), authorizes the Town's adoption of a resolution and the taking of a position of advocacy on any issue pending before the electorate.

OF THE TOWN MEAD, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:**


