## RESOLUTION NO. 19-R-2000

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2001, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2001, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, has by ordinance made the proper tax levy upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town, such levy representing the amount of taxes for the Town's purposes necessary to provide for pavement during the 2001 fiscal year of all property authorized demands upon the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, is now desirous of making appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year of 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is required by state law to adopt an annual appropriations ordinance prior to December 15, 2000.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO:

Section 1. The following appropriations are herby made for the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2001, and ending December 31, 2001:
