

RESOLUTION NO. 4 - 1999

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1999, AND ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, 1999, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, has by resolution made the proper tax levy upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town, such levy representing the amount of taxes for the Town's purposes necessary to provide for payments during the 1999 fiscal year of all properly authorized demands upon the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, is now desirous of making appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year of 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is required by state law to adopt an annual appropriations ordinance prior to December 15, 1999.


Section 1. The following appropriations are hereby made for the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1999, and ending December 31, 1999:

General Fund	\$562,371
Road & Bridge Fund	311,590
Park Fund	100,122
Conservation Trust Fund	8,200
Water Fund	1,114,806
Sewer Fund	185,403
Storm Drainage Fund	<u>60,000</u>
TOTAL	\$2,342,492

Section 2. In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, this Resolution is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect after passage.
