RESOLUTION NO. 17-1999

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2000, TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO FOR THE 2000 BUDGET YEAR

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 13, 1999 and:

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is \$254,199, and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for bonds and interest is \$12,990, and

WHEREAS, the 1999 valuation for assessment for the Town of Mead as certified by the County Assessor is \$19,874,010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Mead during the 2000 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 12.791 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Mead for the year 2000.

Section 2. That for the purpose of meeting all bonds and interest of the Town of Mead during the 2000 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.654 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Mead for the Year 2000.

Section 3. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Mead as is herein set forth.
