

RESOLUTION NO. 2-1998

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK TO APPOINT ELECTION JUDGES FOR MEAD'S 1998 MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 7, 1998 AND ESTABLISHING A RATE OF PAY.


WHEREAS, Section 31-10-401 of the Colorado Revised Statues allows the governing body of the municipality by resolution to delegate the authority and responsibility to appoint judges of the municipal election to the town clerk, and

WHEREAS, Section 31-10-408 of the Colorado Revised Statues allows the governing body of the municipality to determine the compensation of election judges for their services, and

WHEREAS, Section 1-6-115 of the Colorado Revised Statues states that compensations for judges be not less than five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Colorado, that Judy Hegwood, Town Clerk, is hereby authorized to appoint the election judges for the April 7, 1998 Mead Municipal Election, in accordance with the Colorado Revised Statues. The appointed judges will receive \$50.00 for their services.

PASSED AND ADOPTED ON THIS 9TH DAY OF MARCH, 1998, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MEAD AND ORDERED TO BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AFTER PASSAGE.
