

**TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 915**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, DISSOLVING
THE PARKS, RECREATION FACILITIES AND OPEN SPACE
COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2004, the Board of Trustees approved Ordinance No. 510, establishing the Parks and Recreation Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is now known and functions as the Parks, Recreation Facilities and Open Space Committee (the "Committee"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to dissolve the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to make amendments to the *Mead Municipal Code* ("MMC") to: (1) remove references to the Committee; and (2) clarify that Committee's members shall no longer convene and act as members of the Mead Public Arts Commission, as currently authorized by Sec. 3-6-30 of the MMC.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, that:

Section 1. Article II of Chapter 3 of the MMC, titled "Parks, Recreation Facilities and Open Space Committee", is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Section 2. The codifier of the MMC is instructed to replace Article II of Chapter 3 to read in its entirety as follows "ARTICLE II – Reserved".

Section 3. The first two sentences of Sec. 3-6-30 of the MMC are repealed in their entirety and replaced with the language set forth below. No other provisions of Sec. 3-6-30 of the MMC shall be deemed amended by this Ordinance.

"The Commission shall be advisory only and shall convene to undertake the powers and duties set forth below."

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.

Section 5. Remaining provisions. Except as specifically amended hereby, all other provisions of the MMC shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 6. Codification Amendments. The codifier of the MMC is hereby authorized to make such numerical, technical and formatting changes as may be necessary to incorporate the provisions of this Ordinance within the MMC.

Section 7. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase is declared invalid.

Section 8. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

Section 9. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and make not less than one copy of the adopted Code available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
