

**TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 918**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO, AMENDING
SECTION 2-7-30(a) OF THE MEAD MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING
PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead (“Board of Trustees”) has the authority pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-15-401 and its general police powers to pass and enforce regulations which may be necessary or expedient for the promotion of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Mead (“Town”); and

WHEREAS, at the November 25, 2019 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board of Trustees directed the Town Attorney to draft proposed revisions to Section 2-7-30 of the *Mead Municipal Code* (“MMC”) to permit the Board of Trustees to waive, in the Board’s discretion, the meeting attendance prerequisite set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, specifically, Section 2-7-30(a) of the MMC currently requires prospective appointees to the Planning Commission to attend at least two (2) meetings of the Planning Commission prior to appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to retain discretion to waive the meeting attendance requirement, on a case-by-case basis; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has reviewed the proposed amendment to Section 2-7-30(a) of the MMC, as set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance below, and has determined that adopting such revisions is consistent with Town policy, Town needs, and is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, that:

Section 1. Section 2-7-30(a) of the MMC is hereby amended to read in full as follows, with strikethrough text showing deletions and bold, underlined text showing additions.

Sec. 2-7-30. - Membership.

(a) The Planning Commission shall consist of five (5) regular members and one (1) alternate member appointed by the Board of Trustees. All regular members and the alternate member of the Planning Commission are required to be bona fide residents and qualified electors who have resided in the Town for at least twelve (12) consecutive months immediately preceding the date of appointment and have attended at least two (2) meetings of the Planning Commission prior to appointment. **In its discretion, the Board of Trustees may waive the meeting attendance requirement.** At the time of appointment,

members shall not be the spouse or child of a member of the Board of Trustees.
A quorum shall consist of three (3) members of the Planning Commission.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.

Section 3. Remaining provisions. Except as specifically amended hereby, all other provisions of the MMC shall continue in full force and effect.


Section 4. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the Ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase is declared invalid.

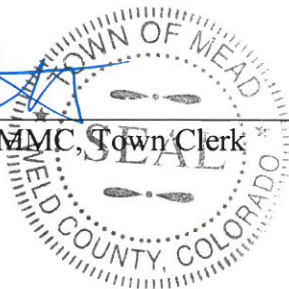
Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

Section 6. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and make not less than one copy of the adopted Code available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.


