TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO. 17-R-2021

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING CONCERNING THE WELD COUNTY VICTIM ADVOCATE SERVICES UNIT

WHEREAS, the Town of Mead ("Town") and Weld County ("Weld County"), as Colorado governmental entities, are empowered pursuant to Article XIV, §18 of the Colorado Constitution and C.R.S. §§ 29-1-201, et seq., to cooperate or contract via intergovernmental agreement to provide functions, services, or facilities authorized to each cooperating government; and

WHEREAS, the Weld County Sheriff's Office has established a victim advocates services unit and is willing to provide services to the Mead Police Department pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the Memorandum of Understanding Concerning the Weld County Victim Advocate Services Unit ("MOU") for the term of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the MOU requires an annual financial contribution from the Town totaling four thousand five hundred dollars and no cents (\$4,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees finds it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to approve the MOU in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit 1 and authorize the Mayor to execute the MOU on behalf of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, that:

- **Section 1.** The foregoing recitals and findings are incorporated herein as findings and conclusions of the Board of Trustees.
- Section 2. The Board of Trustees hereby: (a) approves the MOU in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and authorizes the payment required thereunder; (b) authorizes the Town Attorney, in cooperation with the Town Manager and Chief of Police, to make any nonmaterial changes to the MOU that do not increase the Town's financial obligations; and (c) authorizes the Mayor to execute the MOU on behalf of the Town when in final form.
 - **Section 3. Effective Date.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
- **Section 4. Repealer.** All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.
- Section 5. Certification. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
