## TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO.18-R-2021

## A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF MEAD AND WELD COUNTY CONCERNING COORDINATION BETWEEN THE MEAD POLICE DEPARTMENT AND WELD COUNTY ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES FOR INVESTIGATIONS INVOLVING AT-RISK ADULTS

- WHEREAS, the Town of Mead ("Town") and Weld County ("Weld County"), as Colorado governmental entities, are empowered pursuant to Article XIV, §18 of the Colorado Constitution and C.R.S. §§ 29-1-201, et seq., to cooperate or contract via intergovernmental agreement to provide functions, services, or facilities authorized to each cooperating government; and
- WHEREAS, the Town and Weld County desire to set forth in an agreement the respective roles and responsibilities of the Mead Police Department and Weld County Adult Protective Services for coordination between such agencies in reporting, responding to, and investigating reports regarding the abuse, caretaker neglect, and exploitation of at-risk adults; and
- WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees finds it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to approve the Adult Protective Services Cooperative Agreement between the Town and Weld County, in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit 1 (the "Agreement").
- **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, that:
- **Section 1.** The foregoing recitals and findings are incorporated herein as findings and conclusions of the Board of Trustees.
- Section 2. The Board of Trustees hereby: (a) approves the Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto; (b) authorizes the Town Attorney, in cooperation with the Town Manager and Chief of Police, to negotiate revisions to the Agreement that benefit and protect the Town and do not increase the Town's financial obligations; (c) authorizes the Chief of Police to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Town when in final form; and (d) authorizes the Chief of Police to execute future renewals or extensions of the Agreement so long as any such renewal or extension does not increase the financial obligations of the Town.
  - **Section 3. Effective Date.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
- **Section 4.** Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.
- **Section 5. Certification.** The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
