RESOLUTION NO. 23-R-2023**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MEAD, COLORADO APPROVING THE 2023  
EXTENSION OF THE AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH  
NATIONAL POWER RODDING CORPORATION FOR SANITARY SEWER AND  
CULVERT CLEANING AND INSPECTION SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Mead (“Town”) is authorized to enter into contracts for the performance of general municipal governance and services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town previously entered into an Agreement for Professional Services with National Power Rodding Corporation (the “Contractor”) to perform certain sanitary sewer and culvert cleaning and inspection services within the Town (the “Prior Agreement”); and

**WHEREAS**, based on the satisfactory performance of the Contractor and the ongoing need for the above-described services, the Town desires to extend the term of the Prior Agreement through December 31, 2023 for the specific not-to-exceed (“NTE”) compensation amount set forth below in Section 1 of this Resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mead, Weld County, Colorado, that:

**Section 1.** The Board of Trustees hereby: (a) approves an extension of the term of the Prior Agreement through December 31, 2023; (b) approves NTE compensation amount as set forth in the table below; and (c) authorizes the Mayor to execute a written amendment or extension to the Prior Agreement reflecting the extension of the term and adjusted compensation amount for calendar year 2023.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
